The Malaga Museum was reopened in 2016 in its new and monumental headquarters, the Palacio de la Aduana (Customs Palace), which is why many people from Malaga know it as the Aduana Museum. With a completely updated museum project, it houses in its two sections (Archeology and Fine Arts) magnificent collections that allow an approach to the historical process of society and art in our land from the origins of human presence to the 20th century.



As good connoisseurs of the collections, which we have partly contributed to forming, since its inauguration we have been making visits for the general public and students of ESO, Baccaureate, university students, congresses, etc., often contracted by the Museum itself.
